Q&A

What is the fee for MEDQUEST?

The fee for camp is \$375 per student and includes all meals, housing and activities for all days of camp. Scholarships are available based on need.

How do I apply for MEDQUEST?

By May 22, students must complete an online application, which includes general information, essay questions and parental consent. TWO letters of recommendation are also required, and should be completed by an adult who knows you through school or work. Letter forms can be accessed on the website and must be uploaded to the applicant's online account by the May 22 application deadline.

The application deadline is May 22, 2015. Students accepted to MEDQUEST will be sent confirmation by May 29. Upon acceptance, students will complete the forms required to attend camp, including the Health Form and Media Release Form.

When are students selected?

A selection committee reviews all applications and acceptance notifications will be sent by May 29. Space is limited to 24 students.

Where will I stay?

MEDQUEST students will stay in a secure residence hall at SUNY Upstate Medical University accompanied by staff at all times. Students are required to abide by the University's housing rules.
