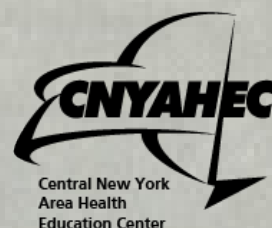

What health careers will I learn about in HealthQuest?

How much does HealthQuest cost?

The fee for camp is \$425 per student and includes all meals, housing and activities for the five days of camp. Scholarships are available based on need.

How do I apply for HealthQuest?

Students must submit the following:

- Application Form
- Short Answer Form
- Recommendation Form from a teacher or guidance counselor.

How are students selected?

A selection committee will review all applications. Acceptance notifications will be sent out in early June. Students not accepted into camp will be notified in mid June.

Where will I stay?

HealthQuest students will stay in a secure residence hall on the Ithaca College campus, and will be accompanied by camp staff at all times. Students are required to abide by all college housing rules. **(Note: Activities will be held at Ithaca College as well as at other affiliated clinical sites in the Ithaca area. Transportation will be provided to all off-campus sites.)**

Upon acceptance into HealthQuest, students will receive registration forms that are required to be completed before the student is officially registered for camp. The full camp fee is due at the time of online registration and is payable by credit card.

How many students will be accepted?

To keep activities hands-on and give personalized instruction, space is limited to 32 students.
