

L. Thomas Wolff Scholarship Application Instructions

Application Deadline: May 6, 2016

Qualifications

The L. Thomas Wolff Scholarship ("Scholarship") is a competitive annual award for high school seniors, college students, or non-traditional learners in good standing **who have completed one or more** Central New York Area Health Education Center ("CNYAHEC") programs, like MASH Camp, MedQuest, HealthQuest, or job shadowing. Scholarship selection criteria is based on academic achievement, community engagement, career plan, character, and personal (summary) statement.

Applicants must:

- be enrolled in a medical or health professions training program in the Fall 2016 semester
- be residents of Broome, Cayuga, Chemung, Chenango, Cortland, Herkimer, Madison, Oneida, Onondaga, Oswego, Schuyler, Seneca, Tioga or Tompkins counties

The scholarship recipient will be provided a monetary award determined by the CNYAHEC Board of Directors based on funding availability.

Selection

Individual applications, references letters, and school transcripts will be reviewed and scored competitively by the CNYAHEC Board of Directors. Recipients will be notified on or around June 1.

The award will be presented at the Central New York Area Health Education Center's annual meeting scheduled for June 17, 2016 in Syracuse. **Please hold that date** as the scholarship recipient will be asked to attend our annual meeting to accept the award.
